From the USDA NRCS Website: “The utilization and disposal of animal manure from animal feeding operations continues to be an important farm management challenge **if producers are to be successful in reducing water quality degradation related to land application of manure**. When nutrients are recycled on the land at rates that exceed the capacity of the land to utilize the nutrients, continued manure applications can lead to a buildup of nutrients in the soil. This increases the potential for nutrients to move from the field through leaching and runoff to pollute groundwater and surface water...” Recent studies say that fall manure placement when there are no crops is a problem. In the last two years an estimated 100,000 cattle have located in Steubon County Indiana, Williams County Ohio and Hillsdale County Michigan in the St. Joseph’s/Maumee/Lake Erie Watershed. Ohio is processing three permits for 5,000 cattle, Indiana none. Parcels are split to avoid reaching permit thresholds. Much of the is piled high on many parcels that runs off when it rains. The added manure is about the same as locating 2 million people in the area with all the sewage untreated and land applied. The manure from this new operation is in addition to 24 million chickens, 1.8 million hogs and over 400,000 dairy untreated manure land applied. Manure phosphorus and nitrogen runoff is the source causing harmful algae in LakeErie.
