Ohio's plan fails to use dissolved phosphorus as the goal for reduction and fails to address huge amounts of untreated liquid and solid sewage overapplied from the new and growing massive numbers of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFO) in the Western Lake Erie Watershed.

Also the millions of dollars spent on Best Management Practices (BMP's) are not getting needed reductions.
